Processing of your data

teamdress has no influence over the data processed by Facebook, the type of processing, the use or transfer of this data to third parties and has no way of exercising any control over this. The data will be transferred to the USA and Ireland, and stored and used there regardless of your place of residence.

Facebook processes the data you voluntarily provide such as name and username, email address, telephone number etc. If you are logged in to your Facebook account when you visit our Facebook Fan Page, Facebook is able to assign this visit to your user profile. Please note that Facebook stores the data of its users (such as personal information, IP address, etc.) and may also use this data for its own commercial purposes.
