Using the Twitter account

Please note that you yourself are responsible for using the Twitter short messaging system and its functions. This applies in particular to the use of its interactive functions (such as the Tweet and the Like buttons).

teamdress itself does not collect any personal data via the Twitter account. The data you provide on Twitter is processed by us insofar as we may retweet or answer your tweets, or send tweets that refer to your account. Data you voluntarily provide, publish and disseminate on Twitter will be used in our services and if applicable, made available to our followers.

Processing of your data

teamdress has no influence over the data processed by Twitter, the type of processing, the use or transfer of this data to third parties and has no way of exercising any control over this.

If you use Twitter, this means that your personal data will be collected, transferred, stored, disclosed and used by Twitter. The data will be transferred to the USA, Ireland, and any other country where Twitter does/will do business, and stored and used there regardless of your place of residence.

Twitter processes the data you voluntarily provide such as name and username, email address, telephone number and contacts in your address book if you upload or synchronise these. Twitter will also analyse what topics you are interested in from the content you share. Twitter stores and processes messages that you send directly to another user and may determine your location based on GPS data, information about wireless networks or your IP address in order to send you marketing or other content.

Twitter uses analysis tools such as Google Analytics and other trackers to evaluate your data. teamdress has no influence over the use of such tools, is not informed of their use, has not commissioned or approved their use and does not support their use in any other way. teamdress is not provided with the personal data obtained by Twitter.

Twitter also receives information from you if you view content, even if you do not have/have not created a Twitter account. This log data consists of your IP address, browser type, operating system, information about the previously visited website, the pages accessed by you, your location, mobile phone operator, the end device you are using (including device ID and application ID), the search terms you used and cookie information.
